**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Jacksons Lane, Wrightington from Bentley Lane, Wrightington to Bannister Lane, Wrightington.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1700 hours only from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> April 2020 until Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2020 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Benltey Lane, Wrightington – Bannister Lane, Wrightington and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow maintenance works on the BT Openreach network to be carried out by M J Quinn Intergrated Services Ltd.
