WRIGHTINGTON PARISH COUNCIL

At the Meeting of the Council of the Parish of Wrightington held on Monday 20 January 2014 at Appley Bridge Village Hall at 7.30pm the following were present:

OPEN FORUM

(At this point in the Meeting members of the public present can report, ask questions, raise issues and make observations on parish matters or items appearing on the Agenda. Reports will also be received from the Police, District and County Councillors if attending – Once open forum is closed the Chairman will only suspend standing orders to allow public participation in extreme circumstances.)

Members of the Public Reported – Further work is required at the bus shelter near Chisnall Avenue to remove trip hazards. A new litter bin is also required at this location. The carriageway is in poor condition and water is still holding on Church Lane, the ditch may need cleaning or the drain may be blocked. It was reported that LCC have said they will be making cuts to non-statutory services however, they did not state which services. Reflectors are also missing on Church Lane. A manhole cover is displaced on the left hand side of Broadhurst Lane, Wrightington Bar. There is a water cover displaced near the recruitment agency. The footway between Boundary Lane and the BP garage does not appear to be swept by the footway sweeper. Water is holding in a hole near the entrance to Gibson's Garage, Mossy Lea Road. It is believed that the yellow lines in this area have been a waste of resources.

Transport & Highways Masterplan, 2 Dec extended to 7 February 2014 for comment if appropriate Resolved: The Parish Council will request that adequate provision be made in the Masterplan for the inclusion of multi-purpose routes, usable by pedestrians, cyclists and horse-riders. The Council will also request that new and existing bridleways be included in the Masterplan and, these be improved/upgraded to make sure they can be used as multi-purpose routes. The Council will request that parking provision at Appley Bridge Railway Station be improved, enhanced and increased to alleviate significant parking problems and to improve highway safety, which is seriously compromised on Appley Lane North. The Council will suggest that the route from Skull House Lane, around the Quarry, to Mill Lane be improved and enhanced to create a walking and cycle route for use by children and parents to improve access to the school on Finch Lane in Appley Bridge. Councillor Mrs Kay will attend the CVS workshop.
- b) Consultation draft, and invitation to comment on, West Lancs. BC Housing Strategy 2014-2019 **Next Agenda.**
- c) Response to questions raised regarding cuts to subsidised bus services **Resolved: The Parish Council objections remain unchanged.**
- d) Enquiry whether the Parish Council would like to be represented on a Working Group to adopt terms of reference, formulate an action plan and discuss how to progress following the signing of the West Lancs. Community Covenant **Resolved: Councillor Mrs Kay will represent WPC.**

- e) Response from Chairman of LCC to issues raised relating to the Highways Budget **Reported:** Councillor Johnson is still trying to contact Andrew Davies however, recent correspondence seems to be with LCC Officer Daniel Herbert.
- f) Response to request that hedges on Robin Hood Lane be cut back Noted.
- g) Notification of public consultation on Lancs. & Blackpool Local Flood Risk Management Strategy, for comment if you feel appropriate **Noted, on file.**

- j) Suggestions for submission of Capital Bids for 2014/15 by 10 February 2014 **Resolved: The** Clerk will submit a Capital Bid for funding towards new kitchen unites at Mossy Lea Village Hall at a total cost of approx. £2809.12 (Excluding VAT). The Parish Council will request £1800.00 from West Lancs. BC in a Capital Bid the remainder, £939.12, will be paid by the Parish Council.
- k) Late items received which may require discussion/action/observations i) A request to distribute info. from the Tenant Involvement Team at West Lancs. BC **The Council agree to do so.**

108. HIGHWAYS AND ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS

- The footway is extremely narrow and needs sweeping from 100 Mossy Lea Road to the telephone kiosk.
- The footpath sweeper was recently in the Parish however did not sweep the junction of Mossy Lea Road/Crow Orchard garage.
- The fence on the playing field adjacent to Mossy Lea Village Hall was damaged when the tree fell in high winds. The large tree stump remaining is considered a climbing danger. It is believed that the telephone line damaged when the tree fell is the village hall line.
- The old road at the rear of BP Garage is very untidy and full of litter and is becoming overgrown.
- Parking problems on Appley Lane North, associated with the railway, are becoming worse.
- Rusty railings on Courage Low Lane, in front of the ditch on the left hand side on the way to Toogood Lane, need replacing.
- Overgrown hedges at the junction of Bentley Lane/Bannister Lane are obstructing sitelines.

110. VILLAGE HALLS

<u>MOSSY LEA</u> – A room thermostat has been fitted which will allow a constant room temperature to be maintained.

<u>APPLEY BRIDGE</u> – A room thermostat has been fitted which will allow a constant room temperature to be maintained. A request has been received for a door, sliding or folding, to be fitted to the toilets to prevent the draught from the fire doors. The contractor will be asked to fit draught excluders to the fire doors.
