## Correspondence item i)

We have now completed a number of site investigations on Mossy Lea Road. We observed from our visits that, at certain times, there is a level of clustered and potentially inconsiderate parking within the area directly surrounding the White Lion public house. Parked vehicles within the highway are a normal occurrence which, when undertaken with appropriate care, does not result in any concerns for either road safety or traffic flows. However, in this instance, the concentration of vehicles within a limited extent does appear to have the potential to result in unnecessary disruption to normal traffic movements.

In view of this, we will be submitting a proposal for waiting restrictions aimed at preventing the occurrence of clustered parking and disperse this activity more evenly within the surrounding area. This will result in a better balance between retaining the availability of legitimate parking whilst removing the potential for further road safety concerns.

Introducing a proposal through a Traffic Regulation Order involves a period of local consultation. In the event we go ahead with the restrictions, with no valid objections / comments, this is likely to take more than six months to go through our legal process.
